BASIC MOLECULAR BIOLOGY TECHNIQUES IN CLINICAL DIAGNOSIS





Department of Clinical Laboratory of B N Patel Institute of Paramedical and Science had successfully conducted a three-day workshop focused on basic molecular techniques for biological clinical diagnosis. The workshop aimed to equip participants with essential skills and knowledge in molecular biology applications relevant to clinical diagnostics.
